A Note from Ben Brustkern, Executive Director

Happy New Year! I hope your 2025 is off to an awesome start.

For me the new year helps create excitement towards a fresh start and new perspectives on work and life. New Years resolutions are made and we kickoff the year ready to move forward. Eventually, January 17th rolls around and this day is called "Quitters Day". This is the day that most people give up on their resolutions. Sound familiar? We have all probably experienced this at some point.

At Friends of the Family our goal of ending homelessness extends well past January 17th. As a ten year goal we have stayed true to this vision over the last 3+ years. As an agency we monitor the real time number of people experiencing homelessness in our community to understand the data. The data helps us make real time decisions on program design and structure so that we can best meet the needs of vulnerable families in our community. A recent study released by the state of lowa shows that we are 90 million dollars short to reach an ideal system. In the area covered by Friends of the Family we would need approximately 7 million dollars to right size the homeless response system.

Regardless of the challenges ahead we will stay laser focused on making sure "Everyone Has A Home" and I appreciate each and every one of you that walk by our side.

#### **PROGRAM HIGHLIGHT: PSH**

As we wrap up another successful grant cycle, we are thrilled to share some incredible achievements from our Permanent Supportive Housing (PSH) Program. Over the course of this cycle, we served 15 individuals.

The outcomes speak volumes about the program's impact:

67% of participants increased their income, providing a stronger foundation for their future.

100% of participants achieved successful exits, demonstrating the effectiveness of our support and their commitment to achieving self-sufficiency.

Our Supportive Housing Programs provide vital rental assistance and case management services to residents in nine counties in Iowa.

The program is designed to support individuals and families as they transition to stable, permanent housing. Participants benefit from comprehensive case management tailored to their unique needs and circumstances.

Through our focused approach, the PSH Program not only addresses immediate

housing needs but also fosters long-term stability and growth for participants. By combining rental assistance with targeted case management, we empower individuals to overcome challenges and achieve lasting selfreliance.

This was the case for Steph\*, who has been working with Friends of the Family through the PSH program. For several years, she faced unemployment, struggled with her mental health, and encountered significant challenges one of the most impacful being her dental health. Living without teeth left her feeling isolated, reluctant to leave her home, and further exacerbated her mental health struggles.

Over the past year, the PSH program helped Steph\* access resources to obtain dentures, which transformed her confidence and outlook. With her renewed self-assurance, she secured and maintained employment. She also reconnected with her son after years of estrangement and has moved into a new, safe living space where she feels very happy.

We are grateful for the opportunity to serve our community and look forward to continuing this important work in the years to come. Thank you to all our supporters, partners, and staff who make this program a success.
